Bedfordshire's three-tier education system was introduced to provide schooling in mid-sized local facilities that matched the physical, social, emotional and academic development of our children during their middle years.

Through our middle schools, pupils are given access to specialist teachers and specialist facilities from Year 5 – so Bedfordshire's pupils enjoy learning a range of subjects with different teachers in dedicated facilities from as young as 9. Bespoke ICT, music and technology suites, state-of-the-art sports, cooking and art facilities and science laboratories all tailored to the needs of 9–13 year olds help our young students develop their skills and confidence in a secure environment.
