Did you know that your local councillor may not even get to vote on whether Middle Schools close and that the decision may be taken by just 9 councillors who were chosen by the Mayor to be in his Cabinet?

The decision should be taken by all councillors. It is those councillors that represent local people and it is wrong for the decision to be taken by a few councillors chosen by the Mayor. Where is the democracy there and how then do the Councillors that you elected get to have your say on your behalf.
Should the future education of your children be decided by all the Councillors that you elected on June $4^{\text {th }}$ or just the Mayor's chosen few?
Please write to councillors urging them to lobby the Mayor so that that all Councillors get a vote.
Please write to councillors urging them to vote for retention of Middle Schools.
Please make sure that your voice is heard.
